MAY 18, 2026 MINUTES

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

CALL TO ORDER AND PERSONS ATTENDING. The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors was called to order at 6:48 p.m., at Millington Fire Station Number 1. Directors Jay Hanna, Brett Mosieur, Jordan Slape, and Dr. James Woods were present at the fire station. Chief Rob Aton, Jr. and community member John Taylor were also present at the station.

PUBLIC COMMENT. No public comment.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST. None declared.

MINUTES. Jordan moved to approve the minutes from the April 20th, 2026 regular board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

BILLS PAID. Dr. Woods moved to approve payment of the bills including checks 2227-2243 as reflected on the ledger. The motion passed unanimously.

Unfinished Business

Brush 2 Repairs. Brush 2 needs a new pump motor. AA&L Emergency Fire Apparatus Repair is quoting between \$3-\$3.5k for the repair, including parts and labor. Jay moved to spend up to \$3,500 for a new pump motor and installation. The motion passed unanimously.

Summer Staffing Grant. Both Millington and Sumner were awarded a grant this year.

New Business

FY '26-'27 Budget. Jordan moved to appoint John Taylor to the budget committee. The motion passed unanimously. The budget committee reviewed the proposed budget, making changes to several line items. Jay moved to approve the budget as amended. The motion passed unanimously.

CCF&R Update. From April 20th, 2026 to May 17th, CCF&R responded to 24 medical calls, 3 motor vehicle accidents (1 was an extrication), 4 fires, 1 public assist, and 1 fire investigation for a total of 33 calls. We have 37 volunteers.

DPSST's Live Fire training went well, we had 21 firefighters attending from departments across Coos County. Brush 2's pump motor seized and needs to be replaced. Both Millington and Sumner Depts. received a Summer Staffing Grant this year. There is a rumor that the City of Coos Bay wants to have the CBFD run ambulance service when their current contract with Bay Cities Ambulance expires. Chief Aton is hoping to acquire some medical devices (LUCAS CPR device) via a grant for rural medicine that CBFD's Chief is working on applying for.

Jay moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:43 p.m., which passed unanimously.
